A person is generally regarded as a tax resident of the country in which he or she resides or spend more than 183 days within a 12-month period. Please note that, for some countries, a person may be considered tax resident even though he or she resides in another country. For example, US citizens living in Denmark are generally required to file an annual income tax statement in the US.

If you are in doubt of your tax residency, please consult a tax advisor or your local tax authorities.
